ADDITIONAL GRADES OF 'E*' AND 'U*' INDICATING ACADEMIC DISHONESTY

Recommendation

Additional grades of 'E*' and 'U*' indicating Academic Dishonesty

| Grade Symbol | Description | Grade Points per Credit (GPA calc) | Academic Credit | Repeat Applicable | Renewal Indicator Applicable | Definition |

| E* | Effort Unsatisfactory due to Academic Dishonesty | N/A | No | Yes | Yes | Indicates Effort Unsatisfactory due to academic dishonesty in a pass/fail course. Can only be administratively changed to E by the Registrar or their designee if authorized by Office of Student Affairs when established requirements for the particular individual are satisfactorily met. |
| U* | Unsatisfactory Audit due to Academic Dishonesty | N/A | No | No | Yes | Indicates Unsatisfactory due to academic dishonesty for a course taken as audit. Can only be administratively changed to U by the Registrar or their designee if authorized by Office of Student Affairs when established requirements for the particular individual are satisfactorily met. |

Rationale

Currently the F* grade is assigned in a case of academic dishonesty. For courses taken for audit or pass/fail there is no way to indicate academic dishonesty - the E* and U* grades would cover those situations.
