\*Students scoring 4 or higher on both economics exams will receive 3 credits for EC 2001 and 3 credits for UN 2002 or 3 credits for unassigned economics credit (if already receiving credit for UN 2002).

†Students accepted into the Honors Institute at Michigan Tech are required to take a special section of UN 1001. Instead of receiving AP credit for UN 1001, students will receive 3 credits for UN 2001. If an Honors Institute student takes both AP English Literature and Composition and AP Language and Composition exams, he or she will receive 3 credits for UN 2001 and 3 credits of approved humanities electives.

‡ Arrangements must be made with the humanities modern languages director.
