Time to Renew Family Area Contracts

Residents of the Family Area will be renewing their contracts during March. New contracts, along with updated terms and conditions, were mailed February 27. Residents who wish to continue to live in their apartment should return their signed contracts to the Daniell Heights office no later than April 10. Contract holders who do not wish to continue residency in the Heights should submit a vacate notice no later than April 10. If your vacate date is between April 25 - May 9, you are responsible for a 30-day notice. If your vacate date is prior to April 25 and you are not applying for a summer extension, you are responsible for a 60-day notice.

Individuals who wish just to continue through the summer should come to the Daniell Heights office and fill out a summer extension application by April 10.

Food Corner

It is often thought that if March comes in like a lamb, it will be sure to leave like a lion or if it comes in like a lion, it will be sure to leave like a lamb. What better way to celebrate March than by making cupcakes that will represent either the lion or the lamb weather forecast!

Lion and Lamb Cupcake

Using your favorite cake mix recipe, make 1 dozen cupcakes.

Recipe Ingredients:

For the Lion

- 6 cupcakes
- Yellow icing
- 30 orange and 6 yellow medium gumdrops
- 18 chocolate chips
- 6 pieces of red shoestring licorice



For the Lamb

- 6 cupcakes
- 6 Hershey Milk Chocolate Swoops
- 12 brown, 6 black, and 6 pink jellybeans
- Mini nonpareils

Lion directions:

Frost the cupcakes with the yellow icing. For the mane and whiskers (for each cupcake), slice 5 orange gumdrops and 1 yellow gumdrop in half vertically. Arrange the orange gumdrop halves around the cupcake. Then cut a small horizontal slit in each yellow gumdrop half. Press three 1-inch pieces of red licorice into each slit and set the whiskered gumdrops on the cupcake. Add chocolate chips for the eyes and nose and dot the eyes with icing.

Vacating Reminder

We are only a few weeks away from the first day of Spring. That means we are half-way through the spring semester, so here is a reminder about the vacating policy.

- If you plan to leave your apartment at the end of the semester, a vacate notice must be filed with the office 30 days before you plan to leave.
- If you are leaving in the middle of a semester, a vacate notice must be filled out 60 days in advance.

Lamb directions:

Frost the cupcakes with the white icing. Using a sharp knife, shape the sides of a Hershey's Milk Chocolate Swoop (for each cupcake) to make it triangular in shape. Place it on the middle of the cupcake. Add brown jelly beans for ears, and cover the remaining frosted space with nonpareils. For the eyes and nose, cut the ends off the black and pink jelly beans. Put a dot of icing on the back of the jelly bean slices and arrange them on the Swoop for the face of the lamb.
