The rhubarb is ripe and waiting to be picked! For a delicious muffin recipe using some of your garden or market rhubarb, try this streusel muffin recipe.



## RHUBARB STREUSEL MUFFINS

### Recipe Ingredients:

Streusel Ingredients:

1/4 cup brown sugar

1/4 cup chopped nuts

1/2 teaspoon cinnamon

1 tablespoon flour

1 tablespoon butter

Muffin Batter:

2 cups cut up rhubarb (1/2 pound)

1 cup brown sugar, divided

1/2 cup butter, melted

1/4 cup milk

1 egg

2 cups flour

1 tablespoon baking powder

1/2 teaspoon baking soda

1/2 teaspoon salt

1/2 teaspoon cinnamon



### Preparation:

Heat the oven to 425 degrees. Combine streusel ingredients with a fork and set aside. In a small sauce pan, simmer rhubarb until tender (about 10 minutes). Add 1/2 cup brown sugar and butter. Cool slightly. Add milk and egg. Blend well. In another bowl, mix flour, 1/2 cup brown sugar, baking powder, soda, salt, and cinnamon. Add rhubarb mixture to dry ingredients and blend until just moistened. Fill greased muffin cups 1/3 full with batter. Sprinkle with half the streusel topping. Repeat with remaining batter and streusel. Bake for 15 to 20 minutes. Makes 12 muffins.
