RECEPTION DESKS

All residence hall reception desks will close at **8:00PM on Friday, November 18**, and will reopen for normal business at **12:00PM on Sunday, November 27**.

There will be **no mail service during the break**. All mail will be held at the desks and slotted when the desks reopen.

All checked-out items must be returned to the desk by **8:00PM on Thursday, November 17**.

STAYING

If you are planning to stay in the hall during break, you must register at the reception desk by **Thursday, November 17**. You must also register if you are returning early, prior to **November 27**. There is no extra charge to stay over the fall break.

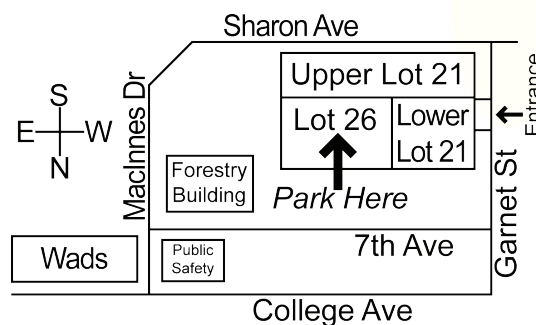
Kitchenettes will be open in all residence halls over the break period.

All residence hall entrances will be locked at 8:00PM on Friday, November 18. You can enter the building using your student ID while the doors are locked. The main entrance doors will reopen on **Sunday, November 27 at 12:00 noon**.

PARKING

We encourage you to leave your car at home if you don't use it on a regular basis due to the narrowing of parking lots in the winter.

If you are leaving your vehicle on campus during break, you must park it in the northwest side of commuter Lot 26 by **Sunday, November 20** and move it back into your assigned lot by **Sunday, November 27 by 11:00PM**. If you leave it in your assigned lot, it may be towed away at owner's expense. For more information, see your RA's posting board.

- All electric items must have UL seal approval.
- No candles or flammable decorations.
- No electric devices are allowed on metallic trees.
- Decorations must be removed by no later than **12:00 noon on December 16.**

BIKE RACKS

Bikes must be removed from the racks by **Friday, November 18.**

Bike locks will be cut and bikes will be left unsecured after this date. This is necessary in order to move bike racks for snow removal. After the racks are moved, you may use them in the new locations.

You do **not** need to move bikes from: 1) the East McNair bike storage rack by the dining services loading dock, and 2) the Wadsworth Hall bike storage by entrance 4 and the trash compactor behind the building.

BIKE STORAGE

On-campus storage for your bike will be available November 12 and 13 from 2:00PM – 5:00PM through your hall council.
