Rates in the academic year are based on 9 to 12 credits (depending on the department) and may include: tuition differential (applies to only engineering and computer science departments), computing/security fees and estimated lab fees. Rates in the summer semester are based on 3 credits and may include: tuition differential (half of the academic semester rate and applies only to engineering and computer science departments), computing/security fees and estimated lab fees. The student is responsible for all charges above the calculated departmental cap (9 to 12 cr. ay, 3 cr. su.). A 6% increase should be applied in future years.
