Overview

- The Leading Scholar Award is Michigan Tech's premier scholarship program
- Academically talented high school seniors with leadership experience are encouraged to apply
- General academic guidelines
 - 3.3 or higher cumulative GPA (on a 4.00 scale)
 - ACT & SAT scores not considered for incoming fall 2021 students



Value

Michigan Residents

- Top awards are valued at full tuition, room and board, and \$1,000
- All other finalists receive \$10,000
- Renewable for 4 years (8 semesters)

Non-Michigan Residents

- Top awards are valued at full nonresident tuition
- All other finalists receive \$20,000
- Renewable for 4 years (8 semesters)

Alumni Legacy and Military Family Education Recipients

Finalist will receive the Michigan value of their scholarship






How to Apply

- Write approximately a one-page essay (3,000 characters including spaces)



Leading Scholar Award Application

The Leading Scholar Award is Michigan Technological University's most prestigious award available to incoming first-year students who are US citizens. You must have the following to submit your application

- One (1) letter of recommendation
- A one-page essay

Letter of Recommendation

- You must submit your mentor's name, organization they work with, title, relationship to you, and email address.
- Your recommendation should come from a teacher, counselor, coach, or community member (we strongly encourage you not to use a family member).
- It may be beneficial to create a list of your accomplishments and provide this to your mentor.
- You may change who you have selected to submit your recommendation, but keep in mind your mentor must submit their recommendation October 15 at 11:59 p.m.

To change your recommender: click Edit next to their name, then click Exclude on the next page. Return to this screen and select Add Recommender.


To send a reminder to your recommender: click Edit next to their name, then click on Send Reminder on the next page.

Essay Tips

- Be distinctive
 - What have you done that benefits your school or community
 - Where have you travelled to that made an impact globally
- Don't over think the essay
 - Write about what you want to write about
 - Tell us your story (avoid the resume)
- Proofread your work
- Length
 - Longer isn't necessarily better
