- Collaborate with faculty to apply for NSF Grant for creating a Bot to detect on-line academic integrity violations.
- Create a course on academic integrity.
- Partner w/ Educational Outreach to offer presentations/workshops on academic integrity for local schools.
- Create an Integrity/Civility Pledge.

Academic Misconduct Data

The number of academic misconduct cases declined by 19% during the 2021-2022 academic year. The return to in-person classes was a huge contributor to this. Also, presentations to academic departments, individual classes, and student groups helped to bring about more awareness. Finally, the development of various resources for faculty helped to address some of the concerns for academic integrity.
