
## Bachelor of Science - Computer Engineering

SAMPLE PLAN Calculus-ready students



1) If considering BSEE or another Engineering major: Choose CH1150/51 for your Math/Sci 2<sup>nd</sup> discipline.
2) Technical Electives: If doing Senior Design: choose 12 credits of Technical Electives from approved list of CpE Tech Electives. If doing Enterprise: choose 10 credits from approved list of CpE Tech Electives.

3) Choose either CS3331 or EE3160: The other may be used for technical elective credits, if desired.

4) Eligible Math/Sci electives: MA2600, MA2910, MA3000 or higher; BL1010 or higher; CH1150 or higher; PH2300 or higher (with some exclusions; see degree audit for complete list)

5) HASS electives: 6 credits must be upper division 3000-4000. UN1015 & UN1025 are prerequisites for upper division HASS

(A) Capstone Options. Choose at start of third year.

Senior Design: After EE 3901, take EE4901 and EE4910. Enterprise for Design: May take 4 semesters of Enterprise in lieu of EE4901 and EE4910. ENT4950 & ENT4960 must be consecutive & same enterprise. ENT3950 & ENT3960 may apply toward Technical Electives. EPS: European Project Semester; fulfills EE3901, 4901 & 4910.
