Gierke attempted to convey that the ABET accreditation considerations are important drivers but that we approach our ABET assessment activities and addressing program needs in both an altruistic sense, from the standpoint of what makes sense for the strengths and vision for our programs, and with attention to ABET criteria and making sure we meet or exceed what is required for accreditation. The ABET aspects mostly drive the format of our reporting and assessment, rather than driving all our our planning and curriculum adaptations.
- Overview and discussion of student outcomes: John Gierke
 - o Include/update the ability to evaluate risk and uncertainty
 - o Continue/enhance emphasis on effective communication skills, both oral and written, including communication with the nontechnical public
 - o Gierke brought up that as a department, increasingly we are striving to foster computational skills among our students.
 - o more discussion needed about addressing perceived weaknesses in new graduates being unable to properly interpret site investigation data and develop appropriate conceptual site models. This is not a perceived weakness of our graduates per se, but a general view of

- engineers entering the workforce that focus on geological systems
- o Continue to emphasize the importance of surface geophysics in our program, something of a program signature
