Michigan Technological University's output impact was nearly 10 times the state funding it received in FY 2016, which was \$46.7 million.

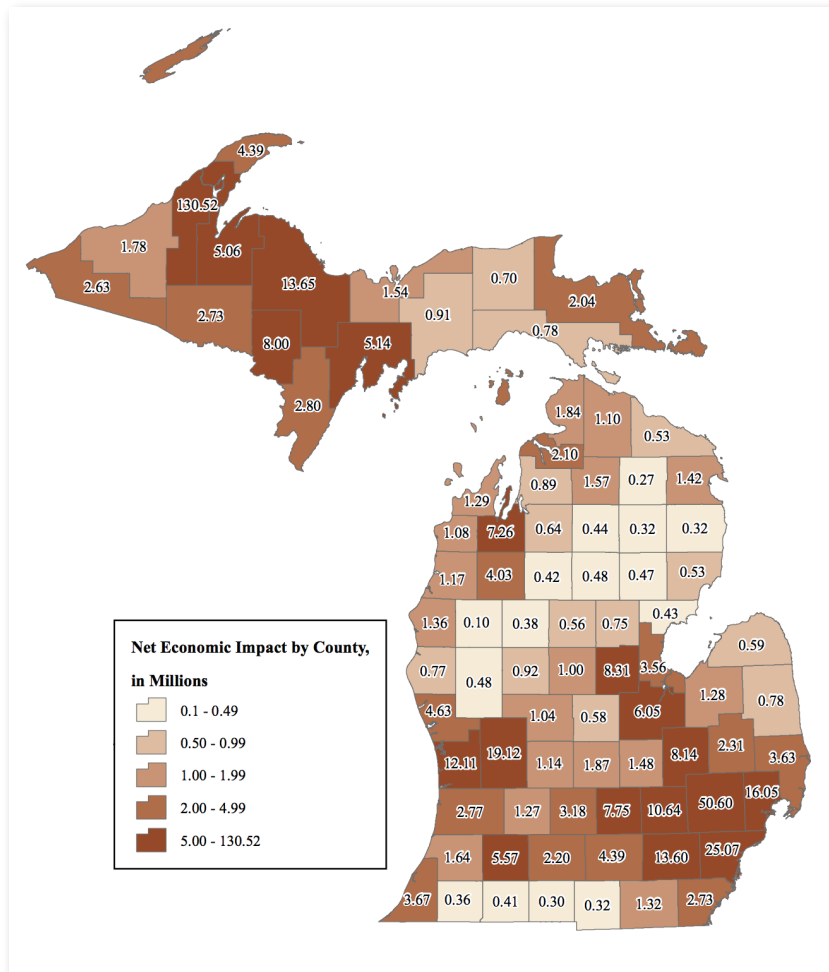
Michigan Tech:

- Contributed nearly \$450MM to Michigan's Economy
- Increased spending in the state by \$448 million
- Increased employment by 4,258 jobs
- Has 26,000 alumni living in Michigan, earning more than 1.4 billion in salaries and wages in 2016
- Enrolled over 7,200 students, 10% higher than its enrollment a decade ago. These students spend \$66MM contributing significantly to the regional and state economy
- Awarded 1,700 degrees with a majority in STEM fields
- Spent \$72.5MM on research and development
