

STUDY ABROAD IN 10 STEPS

1

Initial planning

Attend a study abroad 101 session (Tues. @ 11:00, Thur. @ 2:00, M&M 722). Meet with your academic advisor to find out how study abroad may fit into your academic plan.

2

Research travel programs

Create your Via TRM traveler profile. Browse travel programs & select your program.

3

Select courses & request course evaluations

After application submission, begin the study abroad course evaluation & planning process.

4

Complete your study abroad course plan

Finalize your study abroad course plan with your academic advisor.

5

Research & apply for study abroad scholarships

Meet with the Financial Aid office to discuss your budget. Review scholarship opportunities mtu.edu/studyabroad.

6

Receive home university approval

Your Michigan Tech study abroad application is reviewed by Pavlis Honors College & approved by the Dean of Students.

7

Submit your program provider application

After your Michigan Tech study abroad application is approved, you are required to submit your program provider application.

8

Register for courses through your program provider

Reference your Michigan Tech study abroad course form to register for study abroad courses.

9

Attend study abroad pre-departure 201 & 301 sessions

201: passports, visas & airfare
301: health & safety, cultural adjustments, packing & finance prep
