

HEALTH SAVINGS ACCOUNT (HSA) PAYROLL DEDUCTION CONTRIBUTION FORM

Save paper – make changes online.

Log into Banweb.mtu.edu and navigate to Employees/Benefits and Deductions/Health Benefits/Health Savings Account

The IRS sets a maximum amount that can be deposited into your HSA. These include deposits from payroll deduction, employer contributions and any post-tax deposits you make during the tax year. The 2025 IRS maximum contributions levels are:

Single: \$4,300 Family: \$8,550

Catch Up: \$1,000 additional employee contribution if age 55 or over

You may start, stop or change your payroll deduction contribution amount anytime during the year.
