



## RETIREE BENEFIT FACT SHEET

### Health Care:

- Employees at least 60 years old and age + years of service is equal to or greater than 80 have access to retiree healthcare. Retiree would be responsible for full cost

### Dental/Vision:

- Employees at least 60 years old and age + years of service is equal to or greater than 80 have access to retiree dental/vision. Retiree would be responsible for full cost

### Retiree Husky Health

- Retirees have the option to earn a \$200 incentive for completing a BCBSM Health Assessment *and* an annual physical or wellness exam.

### Life Insurance

- Retirees have access to purchase life insurance up to \$50,000

### Vehicle Discounts

- Retirees have access to purchase automobiles at a discount going through GM and Ford. For the company code to start your process you will need to call the Benefits Office at 906-487-2517 or email [benefits@mtu.edu](mailto:benefits@mtu.edu)

### Library Privileges:

- Emeriti Faculty
  - Receive all privileges from the library including access to electronic resources, Interlibrary Loan borrowing, badge access and all other library services
- All retirees
  - No charge Courtesy card for borrowing items which includes access to a statewide borrowing system for books/CD/DVD called Michigan Electronic Library
  - Reference assistance from librarians or archivist
  - Walk-in use of computers
  - Access to the Archives
  - Welcome to workshops and all Library events
