## Mandatory Checklist for New International Students

- Check-in with International Programs & Services (IPS):
  - Where: IPS office, Administration Building, Room 200
  - When: Monday-Friday from 8:00AM-5:00PM, excluding lunch break from 12:00-1:00PM
  - Please bring the following:
    - I-20 or DS-2019
    - Passport
    - Visa
  - If you have dependents, please bring their documents as well to be checked in.
- Print I-94 arrival record: www.cbp.gov/travel/international-visitors/i-94-instructions
- Pick up your HuskyCard Identification Card:
  - You will need the following to receive your card:
    - Student ID number (M number) and Passport
    - Upload your photo on MyMichiganTech prior to getting it
  - Where: Van Pelt & Opie Library Technical Assistance Center (1st floor)

- Check-in to Housing & Residential Life:
  - Where: Housing & Residential Life, 153 Wadsworth Hall
  - Note: Only required for students who will live on campus (Including Daniell Heights)

- When: Before paying your student bill, as soon as possible
