The transcription of the data book describes what Rundman believes are estimations of copper in mass and barrel work ores from Champion, Baltic, and Trimountain mines; as well as Mohawk, Wolverine, and

Franklin Mines that would have been received and smelted at the Michigan smelter, possibly at Coles Creek.
