Biographical / Historical

William Grawn Milliken was born March 26, 1922 and served as Michigan's 44th Governor from 1969 to 1983. Milliken toured the Upper Peninsula in March 1978 with six of his top aides including Patrick Babcock, Keith Molin, John Dempsey, Howard Tanner, John Woodford, and Jerry Miller. The tour followed Milliken's re-election announcement in April 1978 and was billed as a "listening tour." Milliken's party toured six U.P. counties with stops at Michigan Technological University in Houghton County, Iron Mountain, Kingsford, Marquette, Ontonagon, Ironwood, Iron River, and Calumet, among others.
