He graduated from Hancock High School in 1974 and Northern Michigan University in 1978 with a bachelor's degree in English literature. Walikainen worked as an ad salesperson for the Evening News in Sault Ste. Marie for a short period of time before becoming an advertising salesperson and later classified ad manager at the Daily Mining Gazette. He then was employed by Michigan Technological University as a publications editor, senior editor, senior content specialist and eventually the director of marketing communications and University Webmaster.
