
In addition, I have included a very brief statement that speaks to my view of importance and usefulness of the results as follows:











Michigan Technological University Sponsored Program Awards (\$ millions)*








Michigan Technological University Number of Full-Time Tenured/Tenure-Track Faculty*




Michigan Technological University Number of Full-Time Tenured/Tenure-Track Female Faculty (%)*




Michigan Technological University Number of Full-Time Tenured/Tenure-Track Underrepresented

















Michigan Technological University Underrepresented Undergraduate Students (%)*







Michigan Technological University Underrepresented Graduate Students (%)*






Michigan Technological University External Graduate Support (\$ millions)*


Michigan Technological University Proposals Submitted (as lead)*


Michigan Technological University Proposals Funded*



*Number of external research proposals funded, including new, continuation and supplemental submissions. Does not include Research Excellence Fund proposals.




