

PROPOSAL 19-04

SUSPENSION OF THE AAS DEGREE IN CHEMICAL ENGINEERING TECHNOLOGY

The Senate approves the administration's recommendation for suspension of the AAS Degree in Chemical Engineering Technology. While it is recognized that this program was a quality program, and was externally funded by National Science Foundation grants, enrollment growth is not sufficient to justify future costs at this time. The School of Technology felt that the resources should be reallocated to other strong programs in the School.
