USG RESOLUTION NO. 2018-2019, No. 1

INTRODUCED BY: Robon Edwards, Undergraduate Student Government

Whereas, Students at Michigan Tech have expressed a desire to be free from classes during the time of Career Fair.

Whereas, the University Senate already supports a reduced workload during Career Fair in the form of prohibiting exams, quizzes, and major homework assignments on that day.

Whereas, USG has been approached multiple times concerning a Career Fair recess this school year, as well as in past years.

Whereas, Career Services will shift the time of Career Fair to start at 2:00 PM and end at 7:00 PM.

Now Therefore, be it supported by the Undergraduate Student Government of Michigan Technological University that a Career Fair recess be given on the date of the fall Career Fair each year from the time of 2:00 PM to 4:00 PM;

AND that if necessary, the Undergraduate Student Government supports removing the Friday homecoming recess to make room available on the University's academic calendar.
