# Proposed Change to Senate Procedure 706.1.1 Section 8 on Timing of Sabbatical Applications

Submitted by Dean's Council and the Office of the Provost Presented by: Administrative Policy Committee

#### Introduction:

This proposal is to move the recommended target date for instructional-track faculty and professors of practice sabbatical leave proposals from February 1 to October 15.

## Rationale:

The current recommended deadline for all sabbatical leave applications is February 1 for sabbatical leaves in the following academic year. Beginning with the 2021-22 academic year instructional-track faculty (ITF) and professors of practice became eligible to apply for sabbatical leave. Due to the high teaching load of these faculty, an earlier deadline for these faculty is being requested so units have time to plan for covering the teaching needs for ITF and Professors of Practice whose sabbatical leaves are approved.

## Proposal:

In Senate Procedure 706.1.1, section 8, update as noted in the following track-changes:

- 1. An intent to apply in writing (for example, email) is required no later than the first-class day of the Spring Semester of the academic year preceding submission of an application., and
- Submission of the formal application has a deadline <u>of October 15 for ITF and Professors</u> of <u>Practice and</u> February 1 for tenured faculty. Applications <u>submitted</u> after <u>February 1</u>-the respective <u>deadline</u> dates will <u>be</u>-less likely <u>to</u>-be approved.
- Applicants will be notified of <u>thea</u> decision on their application by <u>December 31 for (ITF</u> and Professors of Practice,) and April 1<sup>st</sup> for (tenured faculty).

## Clean Copy:

- 1. An intent to apply in writing (for example, email) is required no later than the first-class day of the Spring Semester of the academic year preceding submission of an application, and
- 2. Submission of the formal application has a deadline of October 15 for ITF and Professors of Practice and February 1 for tenured faculty. Applications submitted after the respective date will less likely be approved.
- 3. Applicants will be notified of a decision on their application by December 31 (ITF and Professors of Practice) and April 1<sup>st</sup> (tenured faculty).
