They commented that they are not here to condemn the current state of the University but rather want to bring attention to things that could be improved for students with disabilities.

Comments and questions included:

- We need to work together as a community to change/improve things
- Facilities Management has an online form to report "things" that are not working on campus http://www.mtu.edu/facilities/maintenance/requests/
 - This needs to be communicated to students
- How do we please everyone and treat everybody equally?
- Let's start a conversation on what it like to be injured or disabled

- Conversations are happening but funding isn't always available
- The Board of Trustees wants to hear solutions not complaints
- Transportation Services is going to ask the ADA committee to do a holistic review of parking on campus from an ADA compliance perspective
- Why don't we have students working on Michigan Tech projects?
 - There are 19 groups working on projects this semester with 15 faculty supporting them

Travis questioned "What is next the next step from a student perspective?" He suggested a recommendation be proposed to USG and GSG to form a small committee starting from the aspect of:

- Little to no money costs
- Minimal costs
- Big money costs

Josh will bring this to both USG and GSG. It was suggested that if a committee is formed, Josh should "create a charge" for it. Travis volunteered to help him do this.

Maintenance – Campus Bike Stations

Skate Board/Long Board Rack - Erin

Erin reported that the skate board/long board racks are up and being used. The Library staff is working on temporary signage to explain the racks.

Kerri will contact Jacob if he has created a long-term management plan and how to track usage.

Textbook Cache Project – Josh

Josh reported the following regarding the textbook cache "pilot" project:

- Creative Suites is working on a poster
- Donation boxes will be going to departments soon
- He will be contacting the volunteers to pick up the books
- The books will be delivered to the Library and stored (until the summer)
- Josh will organize them this summer
- He will contact the Bookstore to determine what books have been used/going to be used
- Books that aren't used by students can be donated to the Friends of the Library or Portage Library
- This pilot program may possibly expand some of the reserve books in the Library
- He will come up with recommendations on how to move forward
- The goal is to get books to students who need them

Contract Holder – Travis

Travis reported they hired a student to develop an agreement that can be used between the contract holder and the co-tenant. Currently it is being reviewed by Paul Tomasi. When it is completed it will be posted on the Housing and Res Life website as a voluntary resource for the students.

USG Funding – Jonathan

Jonathan reported that USG funded a water bottle filler in the Library and the Library paid for another one. So there are now water bottle fillers on each floor in the Library.

The recycling bins proposal is still under discussion.
