Updates

Transportation Services – Lynda

Lynda reported that Kristi Isaacson from Transportation Services will be attending the November 8th meeting.

Bicycles on Campus - Dan

At the previous meeting, Dan had been tasked with doing research on what other cities and campuses are doing about bicycles.

Dan commented that it is very congested around the Library and Rekhi Hall and thought signage would be a good idea but that it should also be marketed so students/faculty/staff are aware of that is trying to be accomplished.

He commented that in 2021, MDOT will be redoing the road from the Miner's Statue to MacInnes Drive so we could start small and see how it goes.

Thoughts, comments, questions included:

- Make the campus core bike free
- Students will complain that they can't ride their bikes on campus
- Rollout over a number of years
- Do you have a pedestrian zone or a dismount zone?
- It will have to be self-policing
- Roll-out in the spring (during the time when the bike racks are put out)
- Do you want movable signs?
- Dedicated bike lanes should be long term goal
- Bikes are fine on campus but in certain areas they need to be walked

After a lengthy discussion, the following was decided:

- Signs will be put out this fall with goal of having them in place by October 17
- Housing will provide the signs with Travis coordinating the design
- Prathamesh and Bekah will work on language for the Lode, Tech Today, and the Student Newsbrief for the week of October 22nd with the lead of "You may have noticed . . . "
- Dan will review the area for placement of the signs
- The Student Commission logo and email address will be added to the marketing

Microwaves in the Library - Carol

Carol reported per a student's request, Dining Services has purchased two additional microwaves (total of three now) and the Library has made space for them. One of the new ones will be placed in the cafe and the third one will be located in the vending room near the 24/7 west entrance.

Handicap Parking Sign - Prathamesh
